Offices that qualify may receive up to \$44,000 from the Obama administration for implementing and using Electronic Medical Records in a meaningful way. To be eligible for the incentive payments, a physician should begin implementing a certified EHR by **2010** and demonstrate meaningful use beginning in **2011**. The incentive amount goes down for professionals who demonstrate meaningful use after 2013. No incentive payment will be made after 2016.
